

After a date you can decide whether you like the person or not and whether you want him/her to be your boyfriend/girlfriend






O Do not go on a date when it is dark outside

O Don't leave your drink without attention, because someone may put drugs in your drink. You can become unconscious and lose your self-control.




GOOD ADVICES FOR YOU!

O If you want to talk about your date, make a call to your day care centre social worker any time.


He/she is always ready to help you.




O It is helpline in whole Europe. Ring anytime if you are in danger and need help.




O If you need an advice about sex and contraception, call your social worker, he/she is always ready to help you.
